THE CHALLENGE

Waterford.org is an early learning and education nonprofit which features an adaptive software platform that focuses on improving literacy in the classroom and in the home for children ages prek-2nd.

Waterford.org was in the process of building a completely new product that required a platform redesign. The company previously had an in-house auth system and was concerned about security and staying up to date with the latest patches and updates. Wanting to focus on the organization's mission, Waterford.org decided to offload their authentication and authorization needs to improve security and reduce ongoing maintenance.

As their back-to-school deadline was quickly approaching, Waterford.org needed a solution that was quick and easy to set up, cost effective, and fully customizable.

THE SOLUTION

FusionAuth's standards compliance, licensing model, and direct support ultimately drove Waterford.org to choose FusionAuth over Auth0, Keycloak, and AWS Cognito. The easy implementation, multi-tenant support, and API access allowed Waterford.org to provide new features for account management and enhanced security.

During their FusionAuth implementation, Waterford.org ran into issues with database queries and performance. The FusionAuth team quickly addressed the root cause and provided the right information Waterford.org needed to resolve the problem. LTI stands for Learning Tools Interoperability and is a common education specification. Additionally, they've scaled to hundreds of thousands of users without any issues.

Because teachers and students have different login requirements, Waterford.org was able to separate each user into tenants. This allowed the nonprofit to set suitable password rules and enable appropriate login features such as multi-factor authentication and single sign on.
